Reminders:	
DROP OFF	Supervision before school <u>starts at at 8:15am.</u> Please <u>do not</u> drop off or have your children arriving at the school before this time.
LATE	If your child arrives <u>after 8:30am</u> , have your child go to the main doors and check in at the office. To minimize classroom disruptions, please <u>do not</u> go with your child to their classroom.
DOGS	Please do not bring dogs on the school grounds when dropping off or picking up your child(ren). Some children are very nervous and anxious around dogs and we want all the children to feel safe.
MEDICATION	If your student requires <u>any</u> medication while at school, including inhalers, prescription medication or over the counter medication, please contact the office to fill out the appropriate form.
EARLY DISMISSAL	Students are dismissed early (2:05pm) the first Wednesday of each month because of the monthly staff meeting.
CELL PHONES	No access to cellphones or personal devices during the school day, including during breaks and the lunch hour. There is a phone in the office students can use, if needed.
VOLUNTEERS	All volunteers in the school are required to fill out the <u>Volunteer</u> <u>Declaration Form</u> annually and sign in at the office.
ENTERING THE SCHOOL	Ring the doorbell to the left of the front entrance to be let into the school. Upon entering the school go immediately to the office to drop off items or to pick up students. This will help us make sure all visitor protocols and student release policies are being followed and will minimize classroom disruptions.





Bikes & Scooters

For safety reasons, we request students follow these guidelines:

- Students should ride their bicycles/scooters up to the school grounds area, dismount and walk their bikes/scooters to the rack.
- All bicycles/scooters should be locked to the rack available outside of the school immediately.
- Racks are out of bounds during school hours.
- After school, when you are going home, students should walk their bikes/scooters to the end of the school grounds area and then proceed home.
- No bicycles/scooters should be ridden through the parking lot or the student pickup area.
- Bicyclists must wear an approved helmet at all times.

Lunch Break Expectations

Please review these expectations with your child. Thank you for your cooperation.

Eating time:

- Stay seated and visit quietly
- No sharing of food
- Clean up and put away lunch when dismissed

Outside time:

- Bike racks and bleachers are off limits
- No climbing trees or pulling on branches
- Play safely and have fun
- Soccer Rules:
 - * No drop kicks
 - * No slide tackles
 - * Do not kick with full force

Snacks and Cutlery

Please ensure your child remembers to pack all of their needed supplies for the day. Students are reminded to bring their lunch, snacks, and water bottle each day, as well as any needed utensils for their snack/lunch.

Our school will be participating in the annual Orange Shirt Day on September 27. We invite all staff and students to wear an orange shirt on September 27 in recognition of National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.



Indigenous Corner

Creating a National Day for Truth and Reconciliation fulfills Call to Action #80 that states, "honour Survivors, their families, and communities, and ensure that public commemoration of the history and legacy of residential schools remains a vital component of the reconciliation process."

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation is commemorative and solemn in nature. It is a day for remembrance and an act of reconciliation. September 30 was picked as the original date of Orange Shirt Day and the new National Day for Truth and Reconciliation because it is the time children had to leave their homes and return to residential schools. EIPS will be commemorating the day on Friday, September 27 as Monday, September 30 is a division closure day.

Pay school fees online!

Wondering when and how to pay for school fees? <u>School fee information</u> for the 2024-25 school year will be posted on the <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u> in late September. All fees are due within 30 days of being posted. *NOTE:* Additional fees may be added throughout the year—for example, at the beginning of each semester, as your child takes part in various activities, or they may be adjusted by changes in selected optional courses in junior and senior high school. If you're unable to pay your school fees, you can apply to have certain <u>fees waived</u>. The application deadline is Dec. 16, 2024.

Medical Information

If your child has allergies or a medical condition which staff should be aware of, please submit a correction and verification form with your child's updated medical information. If applicable, you will be asked to fill out additional medical forms via Permission Click (Medication Management, Anaphylaxis Emergency Plan, or Asthma Emergency Plan for students).

If your student requires any medication (including inhalers, prescription medication or over the counter medication) while at school, please contact the office and you will be asked to fill out the appropriate Permission Click medical form.

Lates and Absences

If your child is going to be away or will be late, please contact the school by phone (780-992-1272) or through the 'Student Attendance' button on our website. You will need to provide your child's name, class, and reason for the absence.

To send an absence through the 'Student Attendance' button, go to our school website (www.jamesmowat.ca) and click on the 'Student Attendance' button on the right side of the home page. Select 'Student Attendance' from the drop down menu of our Contact Section and fill in your information. Your child's absence will be sent directly to the school office once you hit Submit.

<u>Please Note: All absence notifications should be sent to the Student Attendance email</u> address rather than emailing your child's teacher directly.

Update your PowerSchool information

The EIPS Correction and Verification Form is available online through your <u>PowerSchool</u> <u>Parent Portal</u>—at the top of the left-hand menu. Use the form to access and update your child's records information—including address, parent and guardian information, emergency contacts and medical information. Reviewing the form and submitting updates ensures the school has the most up-to-date information regarding your child.

When reviewing the form, pay close attention to all listed phone numbers, email addresses and emergency contact information. Also, if you recently moved, now is the time to ensure the Division has your updated address. Throughout the year, the Division and school use the listed information to communicate with families about important information, including updates, the latest news and events.

As needed, EIPS school administration and Student Transportation staff review video recordings, in accordance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy (FOIP) Act*. The recordings assist schools and the Division with monitoring student and driver conduct and may be used as evidence in a disciplinary matter.
